Homework and Quizzes: Homework will be assigned each lecture. The homework from the week before will be collected in the discussion session on Tuesdays. One problem of the homework will be graded and marked. Sometimes a quiz will be given in the discussion session based on the Homework Problems. Homework and Quizzes will form 20% of the total grade of the course.

Webwork: There will be *Webwork* assignment every week starting after the second week of classes. You will get an Email in this regard with an assigned password to do the *Webwork*. Midterms: There will be two midterms. The **First Midterm** will be on **Monday, February 1, 2010**, during the lecture in **EH 1200**. The **Second Midterm** will be on **Wednesday, March 3, 2010**, during the lecture in **EH 1200**. Each of the midterms will form 15% of the total grade of the course. That is, the midterms will form 30% from the total grade of the course.

Final Exam: The **Final Exam** will be a comprehensive exam. It will take place on **Wednesday, March 17, 2010**, between **8:00-10:00am** at the Lecture Hall in **EH 1200**. The final exam will form 40% of the total grade of the course. *In case the mark of the Final Exam is higher than one of the midterms I will drop the worse midterm and the Final Exam will weight 55%.*

Make Ups: There are **NO** make up exams for neither the quizzes, Webwork the midterms nor for the final exam. At the end of the quarter I will drop the worst quiz/homework and the worst Webwork score. So those Webwork, quizzes or homework you miss will count as zero.
