 - *E-mail:* By personalized messages

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Part II.a: *Meetings and Website*: By Display of html files

Each Development (resp. Board) Committee Member got seven (resp. 8) complicated attachments intended for relevance at the Jan. 7 (resp. Feb. 9) 2010 meeting.

- 1 **Problem 1:** Each committee member was to assimilate these without guidance, then print each for the meeting.

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 - *Answer 1.a:* Someone can just read the abstract, in the e-mail, and then decide this is irrelevant to them.
 - *Answer 1.b:* Or, they can read the abstract as a guide to a media file they get to by clicking on its URL.
 - *Answer 1.c:* No committee member needs to print each out or to have them passed out at the meeting.

Continuation on Answer 1.c

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- 4 You can collate automatically produced text material and a few precise notes to report on the meeting.

Part II.b: Use personalized messages

Shawn's messages are a nice supplement to the messages we need for increasing our attendance to gallery and lecture talks.

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 - *Answer 2.c:* Inform YAM members of their contributions, by category, and refer to other contributions they could make.
