- Sometimes she will focus more on the details of the concept or problems, which is great. However, I wish she can also talk about the big picture sometimes to help us better understand where we are now and where we will go.

It is hard to get people to be willing to talk to each other and interact, but for example I had another class with assigned groups, and mandatory group work on the homework. This forced cooperation and by the end of the quarter my group mates were very good study partners. But that is ultimately the student's responsibility and not the teachers. Also, reminders on which chapter we were in during lecture would be nice. So that if I need more than the lecture notes to do the homework I can more easily consult the book.
