I think something he can improve on is maybe knowing all the topics that the professor goes over, no matter if it is going to be on the quiz/midterm/final or not.
- It would be good to have something like a daily practice exercise for that day's material. Right now we "discuss" what we literally just got lectured on. Which turns discussion into basically just a second lecture, because no one has really had a chance to work through what they've heard. This is mostly because of the compressed class schedule, no doubt, and would probably not be an issue during e.g. a regular quarter. Though a 10-minute problem leading into discussion might still be a good strategy.
